Themes

Through immersive learning and interactive exploration, visitors will discover the eight major organs represented by the Organites and learn how each one functions within the body. The exhibition explores healthy habits, body awareness, disease prevention, and the science of organ donation and transplantation in age-appropriate and engaging ways. By connecting health education with empathy, community care, and real-world medical science, the experience encourages children and families to have meaningful conversations about wellness, responsibility, and the importance of helping others.

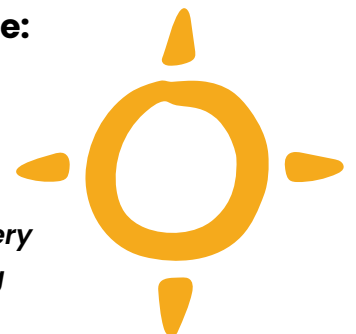
